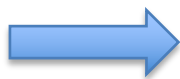


DOES YOUR PROJECT INVOLVE:

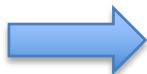
Benign behavioral interventions on adults?

Secondary use of data (not necessarily already existing data)?

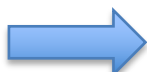


Public data? Or non-identifiable? Or HIPAA healthcare, research, public health category?

Is your project conducted or supported by a federal agency?



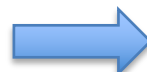

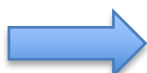
Storage or maintenance of biospecimens for secondary use under broad consent?

See guidelines specific criteria (broad consent, documentation of consent...). Limited IRB review is necessary.

Relatively Low Risk – e.g.:

- Research on behavior (perception, cognition, communication, etc.)
- Use of Surveys, focus groups, program evaluations
- Collection of data from voice, video or images
- Collection of biological specimens non invasively
- Collection of data for non-research purposes (e.g., diagnosis)
- Use of moderate exercise by healthy volunteers
- Review of any Revised Application
- Review of Minor Changes to Approved Applications
