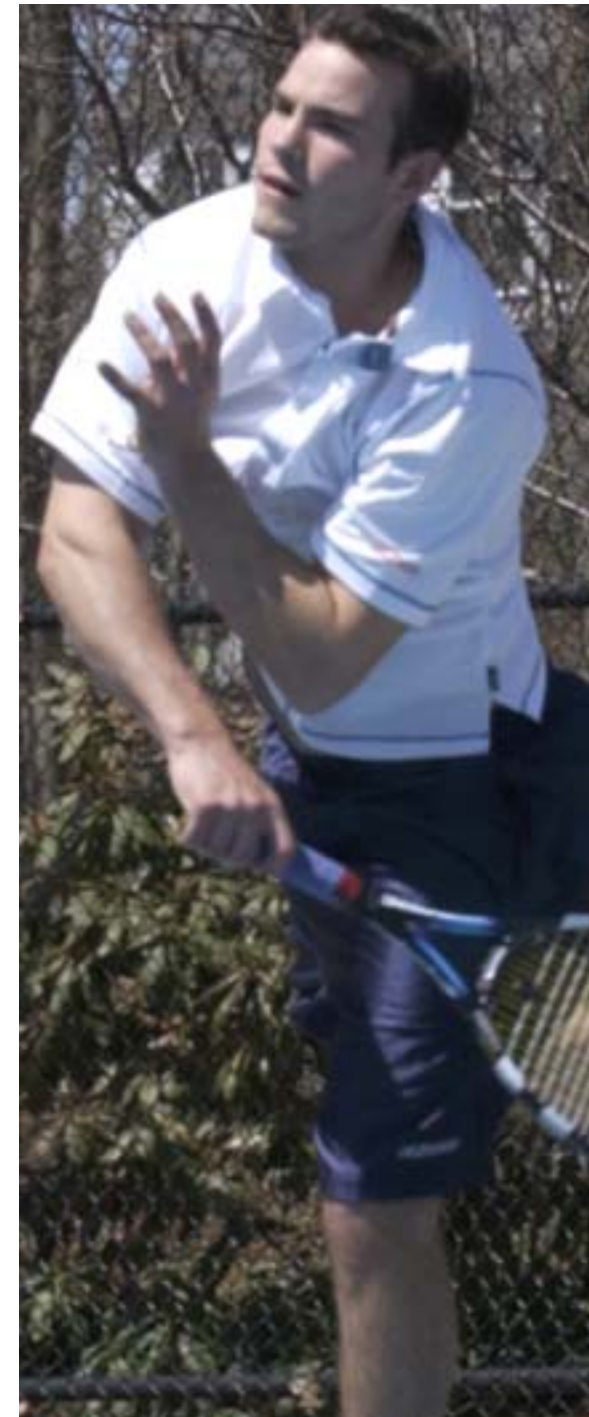

### IMPORTANT TAX INFORMATION

Please read carefully

Section 6115 of the Internal Revenue Code was enacted in 1993. This law has changed how you calculate and report the amount you can claim as a charitable deduction.

For example, if you donate \$500 and receive the travel bag (valued at \$40), you may claim \$460 as a deductible charitable contribution. The IRS requires that you must refuse the benefit if you want to claim the full amount of your gift as a charitable deduction. Check off the box on the reply box to refuse a benefit.

For this reason, the number of premiums offered for each giving level were reduced to allow you to claim a higher gift amount on your IRS tax return.

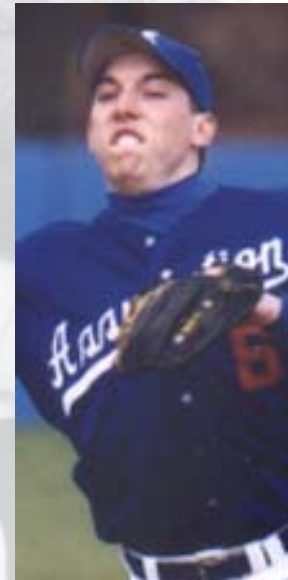
