

## Transition Specialist Program

This 6 course, 18 credit Transition Specialist Program provides training to individuals interested in helping 14 – 22 year old students with disabilities explore and develop career identities as well as develop the skills needed to successfully transition into post-secondary education, training, and employment after completing high school. The program focuses on the educational, functional and social/emotional needs of students. Consistent with the philosophies of counseling and education programs, emphasis is placed on the critical importance of self-determination and self-advocacy in the transition process.

The Transition Specialist Certification program currently offers two certification tracks:

- Certificate of Graduate Study (C.G.S.) without endorsement
- Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study (C.A.G.S.) without endorsement

M.A. or M.S. for admission in the Transition Specialist: Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study
