# About Student Health Services

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**Our Clinic:** Student Health Services (SHS) provides episodic and urgent care for students

**Our Hours:** Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Students should call their Primary Care Provider when we are closed, or access one of the off-campus medical care sites listed on the previous page. Our Public Safety staff is available 24/7 and can assist in emergencies.

**Our services are included in tuition and through the Student Health Services fee.** There are no office fees or co-pays for visits to SHS. **You do not need to purchase the school health insurance plan to receive care at SHS.** However, you or your insurance plan may incur charges for additional medical services, including (but not limited to) lab tests, radiology tests, prescription medications, and ambulance transportation. Annual physical exams and immunizations are not available through SHS. Students obtain those services through their Primary Care Provider outside of school. Call SHS if you need help accessing these services.

**Our staff:** Clinic services are provided by nurse practitioners, who work in collaboration with a consulting physician. Health education for the campus community is provided by a certified health education specialist and PAWS (a student peer health education program). Nutrition counseling is provided in collaboration with Dining Services.

**Students can access our clinic services easily, weekdays 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.** Our office is appointment based. Students should call first for an appointment. Appointments are usually available within the same day or next business day. The only exception to this policy is in the case of an emergency, where a student will be triaged.

**Clinic services are confidential.** SHS maintains a policy of strict confidentiality for all services, conversations and medical records. This information will only be released with the written consent of a student, 18 years or older, or as required by law. In keeping with federal law, no information is shared with anyone; staff, faculty, family or friends. Information about care will only be given to someone with the student's specific written approval, except as required by law and in cases of danger to others.

**Prescription medications:** There is no pharmacy available on campus. Our nurse practitioners can write prescriptions. Students who receive regular prescriptions via mail should do so when they are on campus. If medications are mailed that need to be refrigerated, please make sure to make arrangements with the campus mail room at 508-767-7270.

**Students should bring basic health care supplies with them to campus.** It is a good idea to plan ahead for common illnesses and discomforts you might experience while living on campus. **Highly recommended suggestions are: thermometer, band-aids, acetaminophen, ibuprofen, cold medicine, cough medicine, throat lozenges, chewable or liquid antacid, and antibiotic ointment.**

**Health Entrance Forms are due July 15 (fall enrollment)/ January 15<sup>th</sup> (spring enrollment).** Please make sure to complete the form, include a copy (front and back) of your health insurance card. Note that immunization information must be 100 percent complete before students can move into housing and attend classes.

**Students need to enroll or waive the Student Health Insurance Plan.** Health Insurance is handled through the Finance Office/Student Accounts. Please contact them with any questions regarding the student health insurance plan.
