

Federal Direct Loans - Students

(Subsidized & Unsubsidized)

Students need to accept their federal direct loan(s).

- Log into <u>studentaid.gov</u> with FSA ID (student's) from the FAFSA
- Sign the MPN (Master Promissory Note)
- Complete Entrance Counseling

Outside Scholarships

Students need to report outside scholarships to the Office of Financial Aid


- Complete Outside Scholarship Reporting Form www.assumption.edu/FAOutside
- Outside scholarship funds are considered financial resources
- A revised award letter will be sent to student once funds are reported
- Funds must be forwarded to Student Accounts Office before they can be applied as a credit against bill





Federal Direct PLUS Loan


- Parent is the borrower, FAFSA completion is required
- 5.3% fixed interest rate with 4.236% origination fee deducted
- Repayment begins within 60 days of full loan disbursement or can defer
- Apply at <u>www.studentaid.gov</u> (parent borrower)





Additional Parent Loan Options

- Go to <u>Elmselect.com</u> and enter Assumption's name on the home page
- Select Parent Loans from the drop down menu
- You can always check with your local bank or credit union for parent loan options



Additional Student Loan Options

• Students have limited credit history, so private loans typically require a credit worthy co-signer (does not have to be a parent)


 Co-signers share legal liability for the debt, but many private student loans have a co-signer release option once the loan is in successful repayment





Additional Student Loan Options

- The repayment terms on a private education loan vary by lender. With some lenders, repayment begins immediately. Other lenders may allow borrowers to defer loan payments
- Go to <u>www.elmselect.com</u> and select "undergraduate" to compare private student educational loans



Loan Processing

- Private loan applications can take up to two weeks for the lender to process so apply well before your payment is due.
- Once a loan application is approved, all required paperwork must be completed before the lender or Federal Student Aid (for Parent Plus loans) will send the loan to Financial Aid to certify.



Loan Processing

- Financial Aid will certify the loan by verifying student enrollment and loan amount.
- Keep in mind that loan volume is high during the summer and <u>could</u> take up to 10 business days before a loan will appear as a credit on your student's bill.
- Students can view their aid and see when loans have been added at my.assumption.edu





Student Accounts

Student Account Center

Do you need Access? (myassumption.portal)

What is the Student Account Center (SAC)?

SAC is a portal that presents comprehensive student account information including Account Summary, Activity & Billing Statements with options to pay your bill including enrolling in a payment plan.

How to access the SAC:

Note: Due to student privacy regulations (FERPA), initial access to the SAC is granted to the student at my.assumption.edu. Students receive their portal log-in information (user name@assumption.edu & password) within a mailing from Res life in May or at freshman orientation.

Next Steps:

- 1. To log into your SAC, you would first need to log into my.assumption portal
- 2. Once logged in, the SAC tab is dark blue located on the left





- 3. If you would like help to manage the account, request your student to provide you access via the Manage Account Tab in SAC
- 4. Once access is requested by your student, you will receive an e-mail from Nelnet/TMS* with instructions on how to register as an authorized user of the SAC.

- Assumption University uses electronic billing and payments through the Student Account Center (SAC). This is the recommended safe secure method of payment
- ACH (e-Check) One-time payments made through SAC are secure and post in real-time 24/7.
 - Payments may be made by checking or savings account.
 - You will need your bank routing number and account number in order to process the payment
 - Credit card payments available through SAC charge a convenience fee



Payment Plans

- Both Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 semesters have a payment plan option
- No interest, \$40 enrollment fee for each semester.
- Enrollment is quick and easy made through the Student Account Center. The first payment and enrollment fee are due at time of enrollment with next payments due the 1st of the month.
- Authorized users can see the details of payment plans within SAC under the payment plan enrollment tab.



Electronic Student Payments

- Payments should be made electronically through the Student Account Center(SAC). One-time payments made through SAC are secure and post in real-time 24/7.
- 529 Plans if you are using funds from a 529 account as payment we highly recommend that the owner of the plan have the funds electronically transferred to their bank account and then make a one-time payment through the student account center. This will allow you to have documentation the funds disbursed to the student account, as well as save on the time of processing a paper check.



Fall Semester Bill

Student Accounts

- Fall 2020 billing statements will be available electronically through SAC after students are enrolled and placed in housing (by the end of 1st week in July)
- Email alert will be sent to the students' AC email and to all authorized users within SAC
- Payment due date is Wednesday, August 12th



Fall Semester Bill

MA State law and student health insurance

 MA state law – requires all full-time students must have student health insurance coverage. Students may enroll/waive this coverage electronically through the SAC once they have been charged for Fall 2020. Within the student account center is a link to enroll/waive.



- One-time payment through Student Account Center
- Payment Plan
- Parent and/or Private student loans
- Books & Supplies- Barnes and Noble run the Assumption University's bookstore. Book and supplies can be purchased here or wherever a student chooses. However, please note that books and supplies cannot be charged to the student account. You will need to pay at time of purchase.



Loan Logistics

- Once the semester is underway loans normally disburse to student account via EFT (electronic funds transfer)
- Loan funds will be paid to student's account in two disbursements
- Once the student account has a true credit (all financial aid funds are disbursed) a refund can be requested by contacting Assumption University's Student Account Office

- Manages the University's central IT and Media infrastructure including computer, network, application and video use in support of all academic, student and administrative use. IT&MS provides this support in service to the mission of the University by:

Information Technology & Media Services

- These vital services will be created and managed by IT&MS in support of the Assumption University's mission.
- The IT Center, which houses the main computer room, 4 computer labs and 8 classrooms for collaborative teaching and learning.
- The Founders Hall Computer Room, which houses all campus telephony and acts as a second computer room.
- Pervasive wireless networking throughout the entire campus
- The DiPasquale Media Center, which offers multi-media and video production and two production studio classrooms.

Labs on campus

- Assumption has 4 designated computer labs and 8 computer classrooms, equipped with PC, Mac or dual-boot computers.
- The d'Alzon Library also has numerous desktop and laptop computers available for student use.



Printing on Campus

- Students can bring USB wired printers
- Wireless printing is not supported
- Houndprint and MobilePrint stations across campus
- Print from your phone, computer, tablet to any Print Station



Security

- Phishing attempts are prevalent across email
- Hover over links
- Don't click on links from people you don't know
- No one legitimately asks for your password via email.
- If you are unsure, contact the Helpdesk <u>Helpdesk@assumption.edu</u>
- Antivirus required on all Windows computers
- File Sharing is illegal



How to connect to the internet

- Students can log on to ACStudent with their username and password
- Connect your mobile device, laptop or desktop
- Users cannot connect PlayStation, Xbox, streaming devices or Personal Assistants to wireless.
- Gaming systems will need to be wired
- Personal wireless routers are not allowed on the network



Can I connect my...

- Smart TV: Yes but wired only, no wireless streaming
- Gaming system: yes but only wired. Wireless gaming is not supported
- Google Home, Alexa, Roku (devices without an ethernet port):
 No
- Apple TV: Yes but wired only.
- Only TVs with a Clear QAM tuner in them can view the service for standard Cable TV.



Do I need any to purchase software?

- If you are running Windows, you will need an antivirus software
 - One can be provided if you do not have one
- Microsoft Office is free for all students
- Lab computers across campus have SPSS, Adobe Suite,
 Mathematica, Spartan, Avid, MATLAB, etc. installed.

TV Service

- Only TVs with a Clear QAM tuner in them can view the service.
- Many TV models have a Digital ASTC tuner when they need a Clear QAM tuner to work on campus
- search online by the make and model of your TV or reference your TV's owner's manual for specific model information to find out what type of tuner your TV has.
- My.assumption.edu has TV lineup
- Smart TV's only run on ethernet
