Nicholas Fox Weber, Executive Director of the Josef and Anni Albers Foundation, is a cultural historian and acclaimed author of fourteen books, among them the first full-length biography of avant-garde architect Le Corbusier (1887-1965).

His lecture will address the issue of Le Corbusier's very particular and personal attitudes toward religion. Weber draws, among others, on personal encounters with famous Indian architect Balkrishna Doshi who worked closely with Le Corbusier and gave Weber rare insights into Le Corbusier's spirituality, completely at odds with the architect's views on the organized Christian churches and their hierarchies.
