



5. Please provide a rationale for your response

Assumption had two program delivery options (asynchronous online and traditional on campus) until Fall 2021. It became clear the institution was not going to support the program with the required additional faculty so the decision was made to adjust program delivery options so that the "traditional campus program" was now offered with half (10 courses) joined with the asynchronous online students and the other half (10 courses) were offered in an on-campus setting. All students taking asynchronous online classes during the summer (which is a requirement for students in the blended campus/online program) participate in the residency week for those classes.

The CRC exam pass rate is the cumulative rate since 2011. Students who graduated in 2022 had a 67% pass rate with 100% of the campus program students passing but only 25% of the online program students passing. The job placement rate is based on information provided to us after students are 6 months post graduation.
