
Student Health Services – Patient Wellness Portal

University username and password to log into the Patient Wellness Portal at https://assumption.medicatco nnect.com/






Student Health Services - Immunizations

Required: All full-time undergraduate and on-campus graduate students and ALL health sciences students (regardless of credit-load or age).

For students who grew up outside of Massachusetts: Select the "Immunization" tab and enter all individual immunization dates. This step is not required for those students who grew up in Massachusetts and had all their immunizations given by a health care provider within Massachusetts.

All students must then upload a copy of their immunization record to the "Upload" tab. Take a picture of the immunization record and save as PDF or JPEG.






Student Health Services - Insurance

Select the "Insurance" tab and "Add New" (in the middle of the page) to input medical insurance information.

Take a picture of the <u>front and back</u> of the medical insurance card and save as PDF or JPEG. Then select the "Upload" tab to upload the pictures.

Note: There is an option to upload the insurance card on the insurance page. This is a nice feature, but it <u>will need</u> to be uploaded <u>again</u> to the "Upload" tab.






Student Health Services – Health Information Forms

Select the "Forms" tab to complete required digital health information forms.

All forms must be completed by all full-time undergraduate and on-campus graduate students.

Note for TB Risk Questionnaire: If the system requires a tuberculosis test, the result should be entered in the Immunization tab and then uploaded to the Upload tab.

Student Health Services - Uploads


Select the "Upload" tab to upload your required documentation (must be saved as PDF or JPEG; iPhone users, the system does not accept .heic).

<u>All students must</u> upload a copy (back and front) of their medical insurance card.

<u>All students must</u> upload a copy of an immunization record from their medical provider or online patient portal.

Additional documentation can be uploaded here: immunization titers, proof of disease documentation, immunization waivers, tuberculosis test results, consent to treat a minor form, and any additional documentation that you would like to share with Student Health Services.

Be sure to "Select" the correct description from the available upload items and then scroll down the page to "Upload".





Student Health Services – Additional Information

- All health entrance requirements must be completed and uploaded to the Patient Wellness Portal. We cannot accept this
 information via fax or email.
- The athletic system, ARMS, is different than the Patient Wellness Portal. Since the information is not shared between the two
 systems, be sure to complete requirements for both offices within their appropriate portals.
- Student Health Services does not require a full physical exam for school entry but athletics does.
- Immunizations can often be done through a nurse visit at the doctor's office. In addition, many pharmacies and urgent care clinics offer immunizations. Call ahead to make sure they are administering vaccines and have the one needed in stock.
- ALL students taking 6 credits or more must enroll or waive the Student Medical Insurance Plan provided by Assumption
 University. This is required by the state of Massachusetts and handled through Student Accounts. Medical insurance information
 is needed by Student Accounts, Student Health Services, and ARMS (for athletes). Unfortunately, the information is not shared
 between offices and must be completed for all three offices within their appropriate portals.
