

How to Sign the FAFSA as a Contributor (parent, parent spouse, etc.)

For the 2024–25 *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA®) form, the solution depends on which signature is missing.

You cannot add another person’s signature to the FAFSA form for them.

To add a signature, the **student** must do the following:

1. Log in to StudentAid.gov using your account username and password (FSA ID).
2. Select “My Activity” from your Dashboard.
3. Select your processed FAFSA submission to see the Details page.
4. Select “Provide Signature.”

For a Parent or spouse contributor, the contributor must log in and select the form from the “Status Center” to sign the FAFSA. The student can’t complete signatures on behalf of a contributor.
